# Executive Summary We have a few main goals for next year's budget

#### Continue Implementing the Strategic Plan

- We are continuing to improve and track the effectiveness of our core academic programming
- In order to retain **quality instructional and administrative staff**, we are proceeding with **union negotiations** 
  - To afford these increases, we are continuing to reduce costs and creating sustainable revenue streams (e.g., leases)

Transitional Kindergarten Expansion

- Through state funding and the aid of REF, we are expanding our TK footprint to offer more spots to students
- These needs include adding new furniture, curriculum, and instructional staff

**Central Office Reorganization** 

- Restructuring our central office into a leaner, more efficient operation
- We are acting on the need to revamp our central office structure in the face of enrollment declines

Spending Remaining Stimulus Funds

Stimulus funds expire in September 2023; we are continuing to spend these down in a way that maximizes short term impact and is sustainable in the long term



# Executive Summary Tactically, here is how we will work towards those goals

- We have received additional bridge funding from REF (~\$3m), to help our district increase compensation to all employee groups as we continue to work towards new leases. Combining that with new grants (Community Schools Grant, State TK Grant, etc.), our overall per-pupil expenditure again will be the highest in Ravenswood history
- We are using \$1.2m of state grants to assist in expanding our TK program with new furniture, curriculum, and high quality teachers
- We have **re-organized our district office** and have made **targeted reductions** (\$1.5m+) in order to keep pace with decreasing enrollment
- We are continuing to spend down stimulus funds and **set aside additional funding for future years**, to ensure our expenditures glide down slowly over time, instead of quickly crashing
- Similar to last year, we are releasing **all budget details** in the appendices of this document and on our new interactive budget website to **promote fiscal transparency**



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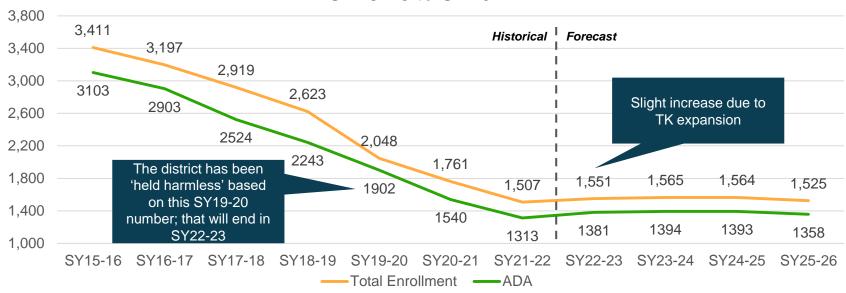

We are projecting that SY22-23 will be the last meaningful enrollment decrease before it stabilizes

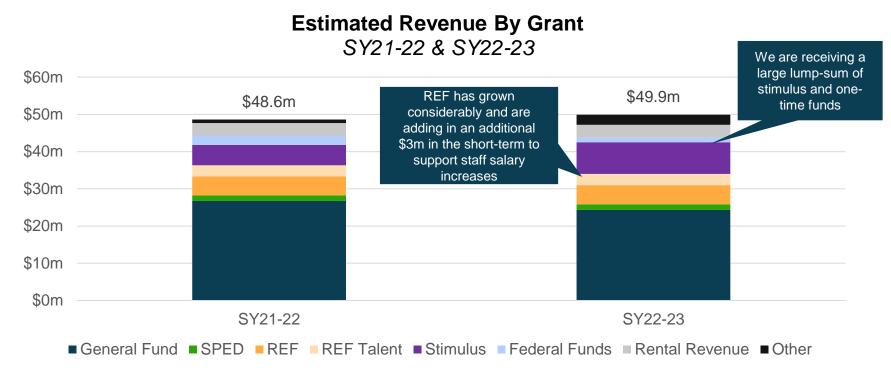
# RCSD Historical Enrollment vs Overall District FTEs, SY15-16 to SY20-21

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Multi-Year Spending Plan

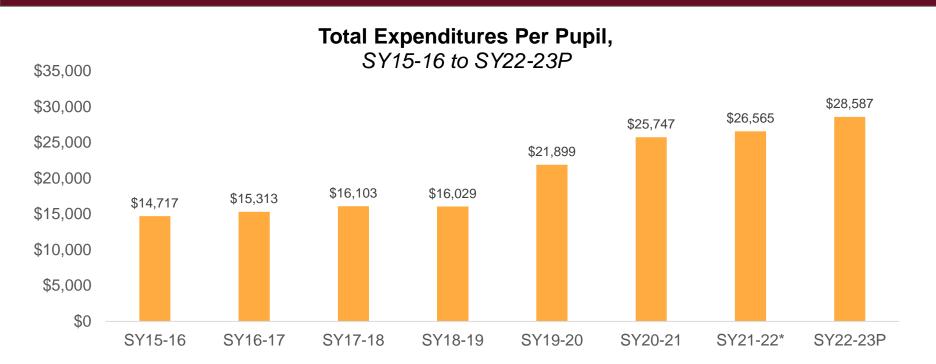

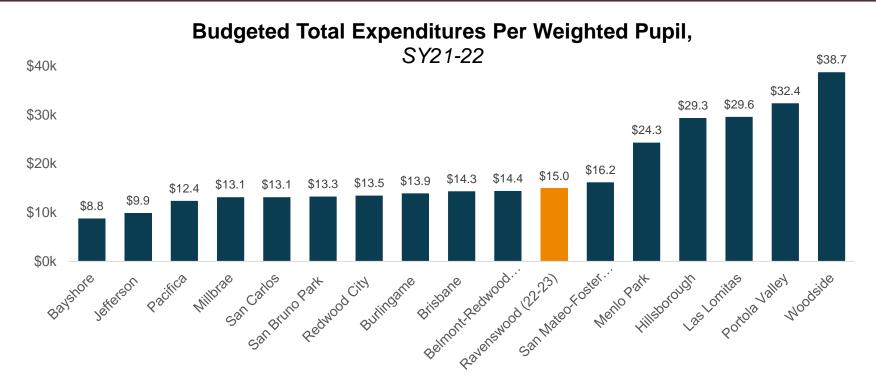
#### Across the county, average per pupil spending has gone up ~15%





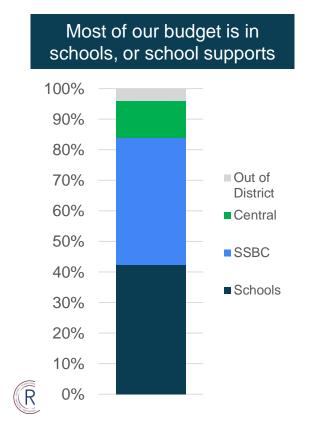


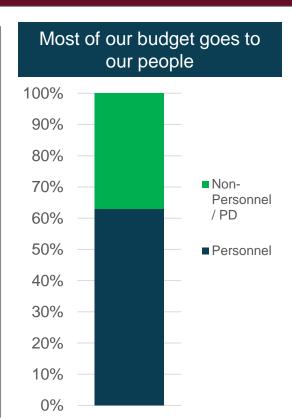
#### When controlling for need, RCSD is now closer to the county median

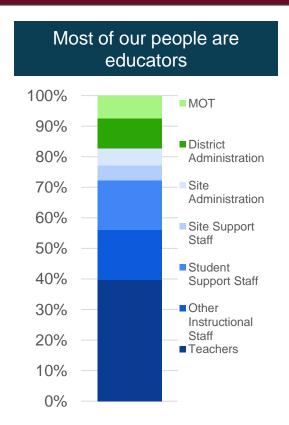




### Where are our resources going?





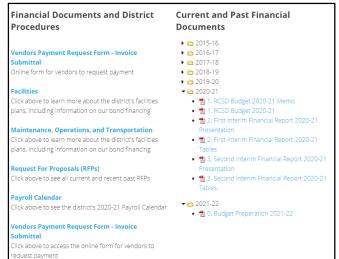

#### **Revamped Existing Website**





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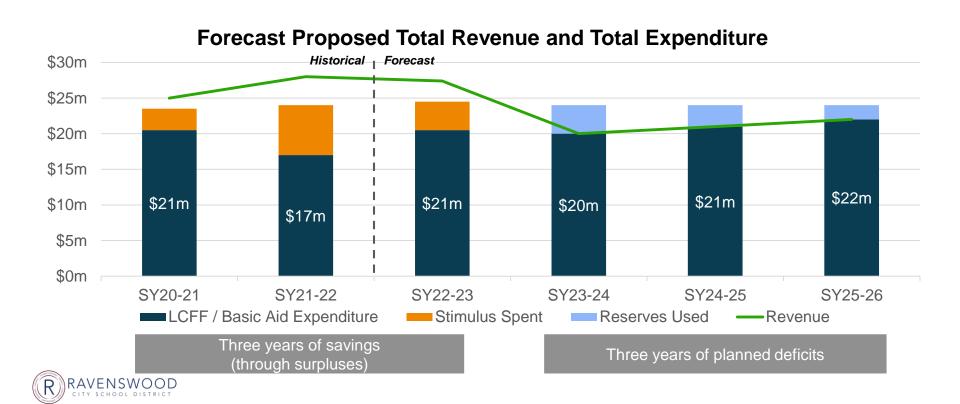

#### **Multi-Year Spending & Saving Plan**

Our plan is to run multiple years of a surplus, followed by multiple years of controlled deficit spending to maintain per-pupil spending



#### Multi-Year Spending & Saving Plan

We estimate that we will need to have saved \$25-30m by SY23-24 in order to smoothly spend down expenditures

- Between SY20-21, SY21-22, and SY22-23 we are hoping to have set-aside roughly \$25-30m saved
- We would then use those to slowly ramp down spending over the following school years

We plan on putting the savings to cover anticipated deficits in Fund 17 to make it clear that these are our designated savings.
