Education Code 52062(a)(5) requires that LEA superintendents consult with SELPA administrator(s) to determine specific actions for individuals with exceptional needs are included in the LCAP or Annual Update, and are consistent with strategies included in the local annual assurances support plan for the education of individuals with exceptional needs. This letter provides confirmation of the SELPA LCAP consultation process for 2022 - 2023 LCAP development. We recommend that you include the following documentation of this consultation process in the **Engaging Educational Partners** section of your LCAP. Additionally, you may consider changing or adding information to the metrics and actions sections of your goals as appropriate, to share how you are providing for the needs of students with disabilities.

The SELPA team provided coordination and alignment of the LCAP consultation process with monitoring activities whenever possible, including attending SMCOE LCAP initial meetings, group and individual work sessions, and individualized office hours with your team. Additionally, we recommended that LEAs include the voice of parents or family members of students with disabilities, or students themselves when appropriate during the LCAP development process. LCAP consultation for your LEA consisted of:

- March 2nd: Initial meeting
- February 7th, April 12th: Planning/consult meeting
- May 19th: Parent/family/student input
